

Computing A Grade Point Average

To determine a grade point average, you need to know:

1. **How many grade points you have earned for each course.** This is done by multiplying the number of credit hours times the number of grade points for the specific grade. Refer to the [Undergraduate Degree & Course Catalog: Explanation of Grades Chart](#) to view grade points for each letter grade.

Course	Credit Hours Attempted	Grade	Grade Points	Grade Points Earned for Course
PSY 101	3.0	B+	3.3	9.99

2. **Divide the total number of grade points earned by the total number of credit hours attempted.**

Total	16.5			38.845

Grade Point Average: $38.845 / 16.5 = 2.354$
